

Community Resources for Immigrant, Refugee, and Asylee Population

A Directory of Resources

Introductory Note

The following directory was developed in collaboration with Executive Director Andrés Pacheco from Opening Doors International Services (ODIS) and Refugee Support Network (RSN) Coordinator, Ana Fores Tamayo. I worked closely with the two to identify the common needs of those who sought assistance. In addition to legal immigration advice, ODIS offers non-legal support by way of connecting immigrant families and individuals to local food pantries, housing assistance, low-cost childcare services, and affordable healthcare. Initially, I planned to organize this directory of resources at the local, state, and federal levels but found that an overwhelming majority of organizations do not rely on federal funding because it poses restrictions as to who is or isn't "qualified" to receive aid, excluding undocumented immigrants. Instead, community-based organizations largely depend on grant funding, sponsorships, and donations to support immigrant, refugee, and asylee populations.

The local assistance category contains several sub-categories of local assistance available. While the 'local' encompasses resources such as transitional housing and nearby food pantries to meet basic needs, I also utilize the 'local' to signify points of venture within the community, characterized by proximity in one's neighborhood which may also elicit a sense of belonging. I begin by outlining libraries in various counties within the DFW area as spaces where one can go to access more information given that many no longer require identification for computer use (always best to call your specific library to verify). I believe it is important to have internet access as many resources listed here function as navigation tools. For example, the Human Rights Initiative (HRI) of North Texas, a non-profit based in Dallas, assists people looking for affordable medical, dental, and mental healthcare. HRI Connect is a multilingual navigation tool, providing resources in English, Spanish, French, and Arabic. The link to the webpage and the number to contact HRI Connect can be found under "Food,

Clothing, and Medical Assistance.” The directory also lists ethnically diverse grocery stores, churches and ministries that aim to serve an equally diverse population. Finally, the “Wide-reaching Assistance” offers a wide range of free to low-cost legal assistance and civil representation across the United States. Areas of assistance may include help with filling out forms such as Adjustment of Status, Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA), Employment Authorization, Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) petitions, and asylum applications.

Note: The information outlined in the tables is limited to a specific county and city; however, the information not listed in the tables may provide aid to several counties or cities. To avoid overlap, the resources were not listed in a table format. For ease of access, one can search the directory information utilizing the control search feature (Ctrl + F on Windows devices) (Command + F on Apple devices).
